

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$0.552420 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Wichita County.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.552420 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.512724 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.578881 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2023 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Wichita County from the same properties in both the 2022 tax year and the 2023 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Wichita County may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Wichita County is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2023 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 7, 2023 AT 6:00 PM AT Wichita County 900 7th Street, Wichita Falls, Texas 76301.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Wichita County is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Wichita County of Wichita County at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by Wichita County last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by Wichita County this year.

<b>Total tax levy on all properties</b>	\$49,672,558	\$54,064,480	increase of 4,391,922, or 8.84%
